- 4. Examine the importance of the American Revolution.

- 5. Examine the significance of the colonial factor in the relations between Great Britain and France from 1763 up to 1815.
- 6. Discuss the significance of the Durham Report in the history of Canada.
- 7. Describe the contribution of Edward Gibbon Wakefield in the colonization of Australia.

8. Discuss the influence of British free trade policy on its empire.

- 9. 'The mid-Victorian period marked the zenith of the British Empire.' How far do you agree with the statement?
- 10. Explain the significance of the Statute of Westminister in British imperial history.
- 11. Trace the developments in the Indian Nationalist Movement during the period 1900 to 1947.

 - (b) The Anti-Slavery movement
 - (c) The Peace Agreement of 1919
 - (d) Winston Churchill
