The Examination in French offered as a subject for the General Degree Examination in Arts shall consist of three Papers of three hours each, and an Oral test as follows:

French I (FG 1): Dictation and Grammar

French II (FG 2): Comprehension

French III (FG 3): Composition and Essay Writing

Oral Test

FRENCH I (FG 1): DICTATION and GRAMMAR

Dictation :

Unseen Passage.

Grammar:

Dealing with the topics given below:

Syntax

Verbs and Moods

Vocabulary and Idiomatic forms

Function and nature of words in the sentence, including groups of words in the sentence.

FRENCH II (FG 2): COMPREHENSION

Translation of an unseen literary passage from French into Sinhala/Tamil/English and questions on the subject matter of the passage.

FRENCH III (FG 3): COMPOSITION and ESSAY WRITING

Composition:

Translation of a short passage from Sinhala/Tamil /English into French.

Essay Writing:

A short essay on a given topic.

Oral Test:

Reading of a literary passage from the Prescribed Texts and questions on the subject matter of the passage, on its literary value, on its writer.
