- 3. Give an account of sacrificial rites depicted in the Vedic texts and the Buddha's own interpretations of such rituals.
- 4. Make an inquiry into the origin and development of the concept of self (ātma) found in the Upaniṣadic texts.
- 5. Critically comment on the Brahmanic view "the truth with regard to the external world is the Brahman".
- 6. Give a critical account of mokṣa and mokṣa-mārga found in the Upaniṣadic texts.
