- 1. Explain why the Buddha rejected the theory of divine creation.
- 2. Discuss the special characteristics of Buddhism taking into consideration the other Indian religions.
- 3. "Morality (sīla) without right view (sammāditthi) and right thought (sammā saṃkappa) is not meaningful in the Buddhist practice." Discuss.
- 4. Discuss the continuity and discontinuity of transmigration (saṃsāra) as revealed through the theory of dependent arising. (paṭiccasamuppāda).
- 5. "The Buddhist teachings on kamma and rebirth are strictly connected." Examine.
- 6. Is the Buddhist teaching of suffering (dukkha) a pessimistic teaching that trains man to suffer? Discuss.

- 7. Examine the intended aims of the concept of no-self (anatta) taught in Buddhism.
- 8. Clarify the five aggregates (pañcakkhandha) Buddhist analysis.
- 9. How would you apply the teachings of the Buddha to remove social conflicts and wars from the contemporary world?
- 10. "The concept of 'the knowledge and vision of things as they really are' (yathābhūtañānadassana) is a special teaching in Buddhism." Examine.
