- 7. Discuss the importance of the convicts and the squatters in the growth of Australian colonies.
- 8. Explain the importance of the Boer wars in the history of South Africa.

- 10. "The Donoughmore Constitution was a main landmark in the history of the British Commonwealth." Explain your views.
