- 3. Examine the tax system of Sri Lanka up to the end of the tenth century AD.
- 4. Briefly discuss the gradual development of Mahayanism in the Anuradhaura period.
- 5. Write historical notes on the following.
 - I. Sigiriya fortress
 - II. Rohana dynasty
 - III. Cino Sri Lanka relations.
 - IV. Vijayabahu I.

- 6. Briefly explain the Hindu religious revival that took place in the Cola period of Sri Lanka.
- 7. Explain the challenges that faced by king Nissankamalla and examine how he was able to overcome these.
- 8. Review the cultural relations of Sri Lanka with South East Asia in the prescribed period.
- 9. Critically analyze the literature of the Dambadeniya period.
- 10. Asses the political career of Parakramabahu VI.
